# e-Gov conception

- ◇ What is Government for?
- ◇ How could we measure effectiveness of government?
- ◇ How to improve effectiveness of government?
- ◇ e-government is it goal or it is a measure?
- ◇ General problem – **goals** of e-gov. projects are wrong positioned
- ◇ Frequently goals is just set of features of existing commercial software
- ◇ FOSS is more flexible adjustable to real needs



# e-Gov conception

- ◇ Inner efficiency, quality of services, more value
- ◇ e-Services for citizens
- ◇ Problems:
  - lack of e-users and IT awareness
  - lack of infrastructure
  - lack of e- services and e-content available
- ◇ **DIGITAL DIVIDE**



# Who benefits from FOSS?

- ◇ Transparency, reliability, security
- ◇ Lower TCO (IDA report 2004)
- ◇ Localization
- ◇ Stimulate competition
- ◇ Stimulate local IT industry
- ◇ Create new jobs
- ◇ Decrease software “piracy” rates
- ◇ Based on open standards (no lock in)
- ◇ Better negotiation position with MS
- ◇ So, who benefits from FOSS?





# TCO study (W Europe)

- ◇ 4000 Users network with local and remote users  
10 servers
- ◇ In consideration: Hardware, Software, Supporting staff, External trainings, services, other stuff
- ◇ **Costs for 5 year**
  - „MS“ software - **37 289 039 EUR**
  - FOSS - **11 490 983 EUR**
  - Migration costs- **4 331 250 EUR**
  - **Savings about 22MEUR (4.5 MEUR /YEAR)**

- ◇ FOSS supportive purchasing policy

- ◇ Software localization:
  - “OpenOffice“ 2002, 2003
  - “Mozilla“ 2002, 2003
- ◇ Survey „OSS in EU“, 2002
- ◇ Spell-checking software „Ispell“, 2003
- ◇ FOSS software CD for schools (2000 copies), 2003
- ◇ Government program for FOSS (action plan till 2007) is in progress
- ◇ Planned further activities in FOSS for year 2004 (Migration guide translation and adoption)

# FOSS Cases

- ◇ Ministry of Environment:
  - 500 computers with „OpenOffice“ - 120.000\$ economy
- ◇ Vilnius County Administration:
  - 200 computers with „SuSE Linux“ - 50.000\$ economy

Both institutions are planning further computer purchases with FOSS



# Lessons learned

- ◇ There almost no transition period migrating from MS Office to Openoffice
- ◇ Most users are rigid and passive, local support team is necessary
- ◇ Some problems with \*.doc \*.xls
- ◇ Some problems with interoperability
- ◇ No way to migrate without strong top management support
- ◇ Forgotten virus attack problems
- ◇ Lack of service and support choices
